



Easingwold Town AFC Membership 2025-26



Following the club's AGM and Committee Meeting, it was noted that the club made a loss of around £2000 over the last season. The costs associated with running the football club have significantly increased over the past few years, these include (but are not restricted to):

- Entry and Affiliation fees payable to the league for all teams
- Insurances and utility bills
- Equipment (balls, bibs etc)
- Pitch and Ground maintenance (including seeding, fertilizer, white line paint)
- Hire charges for those using the 3G
- Referee charges
- Training costs to ensure coaches have up-to-date qualifications

As a result of the financial loss over last season, it was agreed that we need to generate more income. Whilst considering ways to increase funds, we were also mindful that as a community club we wish to stay as inclusive as possible and do not wish to make any fees unattainable for families. With this in mind, we agreed to freeze the training subs at £3 per session for all age groups. To help generate some income and to help cover the ever-increasing referee fees, it was decided that match subs would increase to £4 for all junior players (U7 to U19).

The Membership Fees will remain the same as last season:

Senior Player (including Vets and Walking football)	£20
Junior Player	£10

Maximum family charge of £20 applies.

When a senior player has children or siblings playing at the club, the junior membership is included in the £20. Players under the age of 18, playing in the senior squad will be charged £20, unless they are also playing for our U19 team, in which case they would pay the junior rate of £10.

NOTE: One adult per child will automatically become a club member when your child is registered and a membership fee has been received. This will be the adult named on the club registration form in the section: 'Parent's Info'. In addition, all club committee members and team coaches become honorary members of the club. Over 18's members have the right to vote at the Club AGM.

Membership fees are due by 30th September 2025 for all returning players.

New players will be given a four-week settling in period before membership fees should be paid.

We hope this goes some way to explain how Membership Fees, Training and Match Subs are used, and the rationale for increasing the training subs this season.
