Fee Structure 2026-27

Due to on-going financial challenges at the club, we have made the decision to move away from the 'pay per play' approach and will now require training fees to be paid, regardless of attendance. This approach is in-line with all other clubs in our area, and indeed up and down the country. It removes the need for coaches to collect cash from each player each session and provides the Club with a fairer and more consistent way of collecting training and match fees

From September 2026 we will become a cashless club, moving to a more efficient and streamlined approach to collecting membership fees, training subs and match subs. Over the Summer, all parents will be asked to join TeamFeePay. We will use this to collect player membership details, and you will be required to sign-up for monthly payments.

Membership and Training subs for players in squads that train once per week:

£15 per month for eight months (1st September 2026 to 1st April 2027 inclusive)

Membership and Training subs for players in squads that train twice per week:

£25 per month for eight months (1st September 2026 to 1st April 2027 inclusive)

Match subs for players selected to represent ETAFC in a junior team:

Match subs will be added to the payment schedule at a rate of £4 per match attended. So, for example, matches played in September will be added to the payment on the 1st October.

NOTES:

- New players will get 2 free weeks
- In the event of long-term injury or illness, the committee will decide on any payment breaks
- Failure to make payments will result in your child been withdrawn from training sessions, and matches where applicable, until the account is brought back up to date
- Fines, such as those associated with yellow and red cards, will be added to the monthly payment schedule to recover the payment as soon as possible
- The above fees do NOT include summer training, adhoc sessions and tournament fees
